

The special meeting of the Issaquah School Board held on Saturday, January 19, 2008, was called to order by President Jan Woldseth in the Board Room of the Administration Service Center. With Ms. Woldseth were board members Connie Fletcher Suzanne Weaver, and Mike Winkler. Mr. Deagle was not able to attend.

Staff who participated were Craig Christensen, Steve Crawford, Ron Thiele, Jacob Kuper and Gayle Morgan.

The purpose of the meeting is to tour areas of the district in the general vicinity of proposed elementary 15 on the Pine Lake Plateau. Much discussion has been held about demographics of the area, and the Board requested an opportunity to view the school site and surrounding areas in person.
