

Jan Woldseth called the special Issaquah School Board work/study session to order at 7:05 p.m. on Tuesday, April 22, 2008. With President Woldseth were board members Connie Fletcher, Brian Deagle, Suzanne Weaver and Mike Winkler. Superintendent Rasmussen was attending an Issaquah Schools Foundation meeting and arrived at 7:55 p.m.

Assistant Superintendent Brogan summarized the outline for this work session in three parts look at how district has changed over time, reflecting on data from a district that was not particularly diverse to one that is becoming more and more diverse each year. And articulated the goal for this session which is to clarify our destination: We all know we are headed for Paris. How will we be sure we all arrive in the same Paris: Paris, Texas; Paris, Main or Paris, France?
