Emergency Resolution 1152 – Kuper

Action to be taken: I move the Board adopt Resolution No. 1152, authorizing the board to declare an emergency as necessary for COVID-19, as presented.

The Washington Governor Jay Inslee declared a state of emergency in all counties of our state under Chapters 38.08, 38.52 and 43.06 RCW, and directed implementation of the plans and procedures of the state's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan in response to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) on February 29th, 2020.

Resolution No. 1152 declares an emergency in which the disposal of obsolete surplus equipment, supplies, furniture, vehicles and other district personal property procedures may result in material injury or damage to the public interest of the district. The Superintendent is granted the authority to waive the requirements of RCW 28A.335.180 that the district shall not otherwise sell, rent or lease such surplus property to any person, firm, organization, or nongovernmental agency for at least thirty days following publication of notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the school district.
