Interlocal Agreement – Puget Sound Joint Purchasing Cooperative – Kuper/Olson

Action to be taken: I move the board adopt Resolution No. 953, authorizing the Superintendent to renew the Interlocal Agreement with the Puget Sound Joint Purchasing Cooperative, to reduce respective costs in purchasing various food products, supplies, services, equipment, and USDA commodity processing, storage and transportation services for participating school districts.

The Puget Sound Joint Purchasing Cooperative (PSJPC) consists of 115 school districts and educational service districts in the state of Washington, aggregating purchases of food and related products, including the processing, storage and transportation of USDA commodities. The Interlocal Agreement renewal is necessary due to several by-law changes that were adopted by the Co-op's board last school year.

PSJPC pays an annual fee to KCDA to process and manage the Co-op's bids. Each year the Issaquah School District pays the Co-op a prorated portion of the KCDA fee based on the contractual purchases made during the prior school year. Currently the Co-op's member districts purchases total \$42 million dollars annually on these respective contracts.
