ACTION TO BE TAKEN: I move the board approve the following gifts/donations: 1) A gift in the amount of \$4,709.72 to pay for teacher grants; 2) Three individual gifts totaling \$9,750 to pay for student scholarships; 3) A gift in the amount of \$2,766.72 to pay for a wall climbing locking system; 4) A gift in the amount of \$9,398.11 to pay for the Science to Go program; 5) A gift in the amount of \$10,000 to the Physical Education program; 6) A gift in the amount of \$3,636 to the Gymnastics program.

As per Board Policy 6114, the following gifts/donations over \$2,500 in value are to be accepted by Board approval:

1. Issaquah High School PTSA would like to donate \$4,709.72 to be used for educational classroom supplies at Issaquah High School. Funds will be allocated at \$100 per full-time teacher.
2. Issaquah Middle School PTSA would like to donate \$3,500 to the scholarship program. Scholarship funds will provide financial assistance to students in need at Issaquah Middle School.
3. Issaquah High School PTSA would like to donate \$3,000 to the scholarship program. Scholarship funds will provide financial assistance to students in need at Issaquah High School.
4. Skyline High School PTSA would like to donate \$3,250 to the scholarship program. Donation will provide financial assistance to students in need at Skyline High School.
5. Endeavour Elementary PTSA would like to donate \$2,766.72 to the Physical Education program. Donation will be used to purchase a mat locking safety system to cover the climbing wall at Endeavour Elementary.
6. Challenger Elementary PTA would like to donate 9,398.11 to be used by the Kate Poaster Science to Go program at Challenger Elementary.
7. Skyline High School PTSA would like to donate \$10,000 to the Physical Education program at Skyline High School.
8. Skyline Booster Club would like to donate \$3,636 to Skyline High School. Funds will be used to purchase a new spring floor for the Gymnastics program at Skyline High School.
