

**INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT**

Resolution No. 982

A resolution of the Issaquah School District No. 411 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Educational Service District No. 113 (ESD 113) for the purpose of administering fingerprint processing fees due to the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP/FBI).

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 RCW provides, in part, that “any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action;” and

WHEREAS, in the past, the Issaquah School District No. 411 has worked collectively with other public entities in Washington State; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Issaquah School District No. 411 has determined that these cooperative efforts have been of benefit to the District; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to enter in a cooperative relationship with ESD 113 for the administration of fingerprint processing fees; and

WHEREAS, ESD 113 agrees to extend their contract to K-12 school districts to the extent permitted by law, and agreed upon by all parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Directors of the Issaquah School District No. 411 does hereby adopt Resolution No. 982 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with ESD 113 to engage in the administration of fingerprint processing fees.
