Action to be taken:

I move the Board adopt Resolution No. 1057 establishing the Issaquah School District 2015 Capital Facilities Plan (CFP) and School impact fees.

In compliance with the requirements of Washington's Growth Management Act and King County Ordinance 10162, which address school impact fees, local school district CFP's require annual approval.
