

RESOLUTION NO. 1175
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

A resolution of the Issaquah School District No. 411 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Highline School District to engage in an interdistrict cooperative program for Title I, Part A students.

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 RCW provides, in part, that the purpose is “to permit local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage;” and

WHEREAS, in the past, the Issaquah School District No. 411 has worked collectively with other public entities in Washington State; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Issaquah School District has determined that these cooperative efforts have been of benefit to the District; and

WHEREAS, Highline School District desires to enter in a cooperative relationship with the District to receive Title I, Part A equitable share funds; and

WHEREAS, the District agrees to release Title I, Part A equitable share funds to Highline School District.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Directors of the Issaquah School District No. 411 does hereby adopt Resolution No. 1175 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Highline School District to engage in an interdistrict cooperative program for Title I, Part A students.
