

RESOLUTION NO. 1177  
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

A resolution of the Issaquah School District No. 411 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Clark Child & Family Justice Center’s, King County Juvenile Court Services Partnership for Youth Justice Program, hereinafter called “PYJ” and the Issaquah School District, hereinafter called “ISD.”

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement establishes a partnership and seeks to clarify the expectations between PYJ and the ISD with regard to the PYJ Community Accountability Boards for preventive support and skill development;

WHEREAS, PYJ is reimagining how they support young people within the community, and are expanding their Community Accountability Boards program and are seeking partnerships with school districts to support the overall wellbeing of students prior to any potential engagement with the Criminal Legal System,

WHEREAS, PYJ’s approach is rooted in Trauma-Informed care practices with a focus on early screening and support,

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement clearly outlines the responsibilities of both parties,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Directors of the ISD do hereby adopt Resolution No. 1177 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Clark Child & Family Justice Center’s, King County Juvenile Court Services Partnership for Youth Justice Program.
