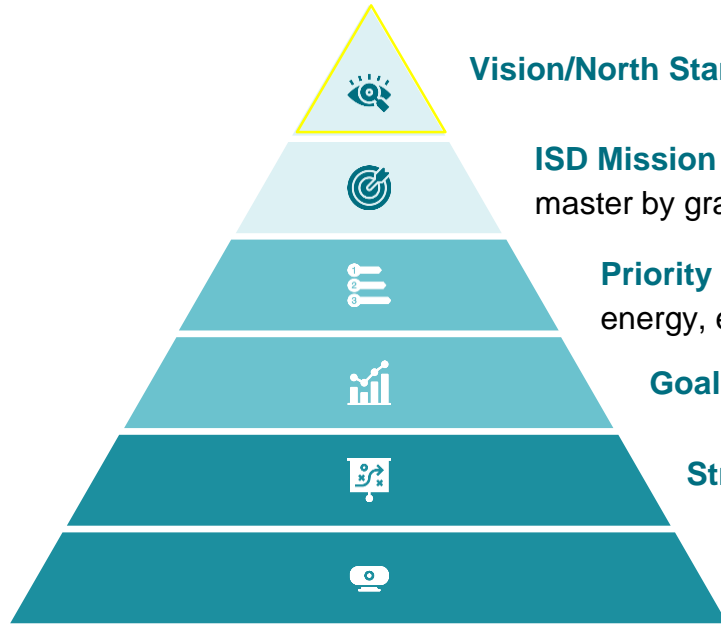




Issaquah School District: Vision Statement Adoption Board Discussion

During the vision development process we received feedback inputs and ideas from multiple constituent groups and from ThoughtExchange

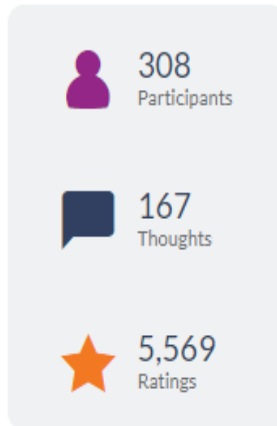
