Key take aways

- Staff all felt aware of EL12 and had opportunities to work in their teams/departments/schools
- We have many shared core beliefs (learning vs. currency, communication needs to be clear for students and families, etc.) but a wide range of feelings about autonomy vs. alignment and the various ways to execute
- Time is the biggest barrier
- We need a common definition of "mastery"
- We need to pursue the ability for ISD to have a district minimum standard that aligns with best practices and is widely communicated (Canvas, website, etc.)
- We need to work with teachers to clearly define what's expected and what support teachers need to execute in accordance with our contract
- There is complexity and conflicting pros and cons about many of these changes (point hustling vs. student time management, how our post high school partners use grades, etc.)



Next Step Reflections/Potential Impacts

- Equip teachers with how to implement best practices within our existing systems (Canvas/Skyward)
- Increase professional learning time that includes collaboration and application time
- Explore a common definition of mastery and a minimum standard
