Educational Programs and Operations Levy Certification, 2024 - Turney

Action to be taken: I move the Board adopt Resolution No.1212

and that the 2024 Educational Programs and Operations Levy be certified at \$60,551,247

On April 26, 2022 the voters of the Issaquah School District approved a 2024 Educational Programs and Operations Excess Levy in the amount of \$64,000,000.

The Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction provided the estimated 2024 levy lid calculation of \$60,551,247. Resolution No.1212 certifies the levy to King County in the amount of \$60,551,247.

This final certified amount is \$3,448,753 less than the voter authorized \$64,000,000 for 2024.

Final values will not be known until late December. Calculations for the levy will commence sometime at the beginning of January, 2024 and will include three calculations (\$2.50, \$3,149.69 per pupil, and the voter approved levy), for comparison purposes. The least of the three will produce the rate and the dollar amount of the levy for the 2024 tax year.
