- Completed nearly 50 empathy interviews
- Attended Pathways Convening in Tacoma
- Started work with Chiefs for Change to develop school model options

Essential Question and Deliverables

- How can we build on the Issaquah School
 District's academic excellence
 while better meeting all learner
 needs and improving learner
 experiences as we design a
 fourth comprehensive high
 school and consider new
 possibilities in existing middle
 and high schools?
- Develop a current state analysis of outcomes and experience across ISD's high schools using surveys, academic and social-emotional assessment data, focus groups, and interviews with ISD groups
- Articulate a future vision for secondary innovation based on input from ISD Board, students, district leaders, staff, families, and community
- Identify 3-5 high school models to test with students, staff, families, community, district leaders, and ISD Board supported by evaluation and case examples
- Build an implementation plan to advance the high school vision



January

GOAL

Develop an understanding of current secondary education experiences across the Issaquah School District.

- Analyze district and statewide data
- Conduct empathy interviews
- Interview school staff and district leaders
- Host focus groups with district and school staff
- Create student journey samples
- Preview potential school models



February

GOAL

Explore and select possible secondary education models or program designs and gather feedback.

- Complete interviews and focus groups
- Finalize student journey examples
- Host a Design Sprint event to generate new ideas with community
- Engage with bond advisory committee
- Conduct empathy interview theme analysis
- Develop criteria for analyzing school models



March

GOAL

Finalize preliminary school model options aligned with vision for secondary innovation.

- Present data findings at Board retreat
- Host two more Design Sprint events
- Share current student journeys
- Illustrate new possible student journeys
- Gather feedback from students on school models



April

GOAL

Design plan to implement one or two high priority initiatives and develop capacity in alignment with bond proposal.

- Design implementation plan
- Work with school leadership to test, iterate, and finalize implementation plan
- Engage with student groups and test options and gather feedback
- Prepare a plan for the next 3-5 years
