

Curriculum Adoption Overview

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Curriculum Adoptions are Critical

Adoptions revitalize a *Guaranteed and Viable Curricula* through...

- Evaluation: evaluating current practice and impact
- Collaboration: bring together practitioners for consensus-building
- Analysis: realigning to research in practice with evidence-based and vetted instructional materials
- Training: universal training provided during implementation
- Calibration: development of Scope & Sequence and impact monitoring re-establishes a greater level of consistency



Goal: maximum 10-year cycle

Traditional cycle: Elementary: every 8-10 years, Secondary: every 7-8 years

Time to reach goal: All but one by Fall 2026

Exception: Elementary Social Studies

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Current Adoptions in process

- 1. Elementary Comprehensive Literacy (2024 implementation)
- 2. Middle School Math (2024 implementation)
- 3. 9th grade World History (2024 implementation)
- 4. Spanish / French 1-2 (2024 or 2025 implementation)
- 5. 6th 7th grade Social Studies (2024 or 2025 implementation)



Phase 2: 2024-25 Newly initiated adoptions pt 1

By Fall 2025 implement new curriculum in... (last adoption in parenthesis)

- Contemporary World Problems (2014)
- High School Math: Post Algebra 2 (2013)
- 8th/10th US History, 12th Civics (2014)
- Elementary Music (2015)



Phase 3: Newly initiated adoptions part 2

By Fall 2026

- MS English Language Arts (2016)
- K-12 PE (2015)
- 6-12 Music (2016)

Exceptions

Remaining: Fall 2029 Elementary Social Studies (2018)

Ongoing: AP / IB courses as determined by certification requirements

Adoption Procedures

Designed to:

- Provide representation and build consensus
- Ensure alignment to state and district
- Develop or refine program and professional practices
- Support community interests and needs



Procedure: Pre-Selection

Charter

- Academic cabinet sets the conditions and expected outcomes
- Now expanded to include, as applicable, pathway development, and inclusion of MTSS structures

Formation of the Team

 Team of teachers and support professionals selected by principals and TLS staff

Survey / Listening

NEW/EXPANDED

• Input solicited from teachers, student, and families on past program and interests in the new program



Procedure: Selection

Criteria & Equity Framework NEW!

• Team develops selection criteria, including the *Equity Framework for Curriculum Adoptions*

Screening

• Evaluation of a range of available curricula to select 2 finalists

Field Testing & Public Engagement NEW!

- Finalist materials are tested in classes; students and teachers provide feedback on each finalist.
- Concurrently materials are provided for public review and opportunities for input provided.

Consensus Recommendation

• The adoption team reviews input and field test results, re-evaluate with criteria and equity framework, and recommend a set of materials for adoption



Procedure: Approval

Instructional Materials Committee (IMC):

 A team of staff and community members review the process of selection and evaluate materials for bias and alignment to community values and interests

Final Public Review

• IMC results are anounced and final public input is solicited

School Board Approval

Materials are submitted to the school board for approval
