Whereas, the Issaquah School District recognizes the critical role of technology in modern education and is committed to providing the necessary resources to support technology initiatives for the benefit of all students;

Whereas, the State, recognizing that technology has become an integral part of the facilities and educational delivery systems in schools and that software companies are shifting from selling software as a one-time package to a license or an extended contractual relationship requiring a subscription and ongoing payments, determined that districts be empowered to respond to the changing business models in the software industry and be given flexibility and authority to use capital projects funds to pay for licenses or online application fees and other related costs, and

Whereas, the State modified RCW 29A.320.330(2)(f) to allow the transfer of funds from the Capital Projects Fund to the General Fund to cover expenditures for costs associated with the application and modernization of technology systems for online applications, subscriptions, or software licenses, including upgrades and incidental services, and ongoing training related to the installation and integration of these products and services, and

Whereas, the District estimated for the 2023-24 fiscal year that it will have approximately \$13,151,283 in expenditures for continuing support of training, ongoing licensing and fees for capital and instructional technology systems and other allowable purposes,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Issaquah School District No. 411, King County, Washington, authorizes up to \$13,151,283 from the Capital Projects Fund to the General Fund in support of such technology costs.
