**ACTION TO BE TAKEN:** I move the Board approve the following gifts/donations: 1) \$73,667.68 to fund enrichment programs district-wide, 2) \$12,000.00 to fund literacy enrichment programs at Endeavour Elementary, 3) \$5,450.00 to fund the Robotics Club and Physics Club at Skyline High School.

As per Board Policy 6114, the following gifts/donations \$5,000 or more in value are to be accepted by Board approval:

1. Issaquah Schools Foundation has donated \$73,667.68 to fund the following programs:
  - a. \$17,730.00 to fund National Board Certification Scholarships.
  - b. \$11,279.61 to fund after school homework programs at middle & high schools.
  - c. \$1,155.00 to fund Career & Technical Education certification for teachers.
  - d. \$3,000.00 to fund ELL Support through the annual TransAct Subscription.
  - e. \$4,000.00 to fund Environmental Sustainability education programs at each high school.
  - f. \$8,012.87 to fund high school Robotics programs.
  - g. \$7,585.12 to fund middle school Robotics programs.
  - h. \$8,829.52 to fund financial literacy through the Junior Achievement program in the middle schools.
  - i. \$2,488.57 to fund the following Academic Intervention Programs:
    - i. Pacific Cascade Middle School's "7<sup>th</sup> Period" (\$1,748.59);
    - ii. Briarwood Elementary's "After School Assistance Program – A.S.A.P." (\$502.84);
    - iii. Apollo Elementary's "After School Assistance Program – A.S.A.P." (\$237.14).
  - j. \$7,151.06 to fund the Highly Capable (Sage) Program.
  - k. \$1,914.93 to fund the Port Blakely Environmental Stewardship Program.

2. Dr. Ronald Sherman has donated \$12,000.00 to fund Literacy Enrichment at Endeavour Elementary.
