

INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

Resolution No. 1056

A resolution of the Issaquah School District No. 411 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the Puget Sound Joint Purchasing Cooperative (PSJPC) to engage in the cooperative procurement of various food products, supplies, services, equipment and USDA commodity processing, storage and transportation services through PSJPC.

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 RCW provides, in part, that “any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action;” and

WHEREAS, in the past, the Issaquah School District No. 411 has worked collectively with other public entities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Issaquah School District has determined that these cooperative efforts have been of benefit to the District; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to enter in a cooperative relationship with PSJPC for the procurement of various food products, supplies, services, equipment and USDA commodity processing, storage and transportation services; and

WHEREAS, the PSJPC agrees to extend their contract to K-12 school districts to the extent permitted by law, and agreed upon by all parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Directors of the Issaquah School District No. 411 does hereby adopt Resolution No. 1056 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with PSJPC to engage in the cooperative procurement of supplies, equipment and services various food products, supplies, services, equipment and USDA commodity processing, storage and transportation services through PSJPC.
