INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN CENTRAL WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY AND ISSAQUAH SCHOOL DISTRICT Running Start on the Sammamish Instructional Site AY

17-18

This Agreement has been developed between Central Washington University and Issaquah School District (hereinafter "School District") to govern student participation in the Running Start Program (hereinafter "Running Start") at the CWU Sammamish Instructional Site.

- A. Funding
- 1. RCW28A.600.310(2) as it currently exists or as amended, defines the method of reimbursement by the School District to CWU for Running Start student (hereinafter "student").
- 2. School District will reimburse CWU consistent with the requirements of WAC 392-169-90 as it currently exists or as amended.
- 3. For Running Start funding purposes, each student must complete and have on file, a Running Start Enrollment Verification form for each quarter of participation in the Running Start Program.
- 4. For Running Start funding purposes, each student is eligible to enroll in up to a combined 1.2 FTE per quarter at CWU and the school district. The combined FTE is determined by the combination of high school and Running Start enrollment credits. A Running Start student's funded enrollment may not exceed 1.0 FTE at CWU.
- 5. Pursuant to WAC 392-169-105 and 392-169-120, CWU will provide a monthly FTE enrollment count to the school district by the eighth day of the month. Student counts will be based on data from the first CWU day of each count month. A CWU day, is any day, where students are afforded the opportunity to be engaged in instructional activity, which is planned and conducted by or under the supervision of University instructional staff, and on which all or any portion of the enrolled students actually participate in such instructional activity.

6. CWU will bill the School District for all eligible participation students at the end of each academic quarter based on the information provided on the monthly enrollment report. All bills will be sent by CWU to the School District's business manager or designee as directed by the School District.
